This program infused new energy into the importance of environmental conservation and the development of the college.





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Inauguration of a Seven-Day Special Camp under National Service Scheme at Patamda Degree College

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
Key Features of the Program



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
Inauguration and Objective of the Program

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
Free Eye Treatment Camp Organized Through NSS at Patamda Degree College

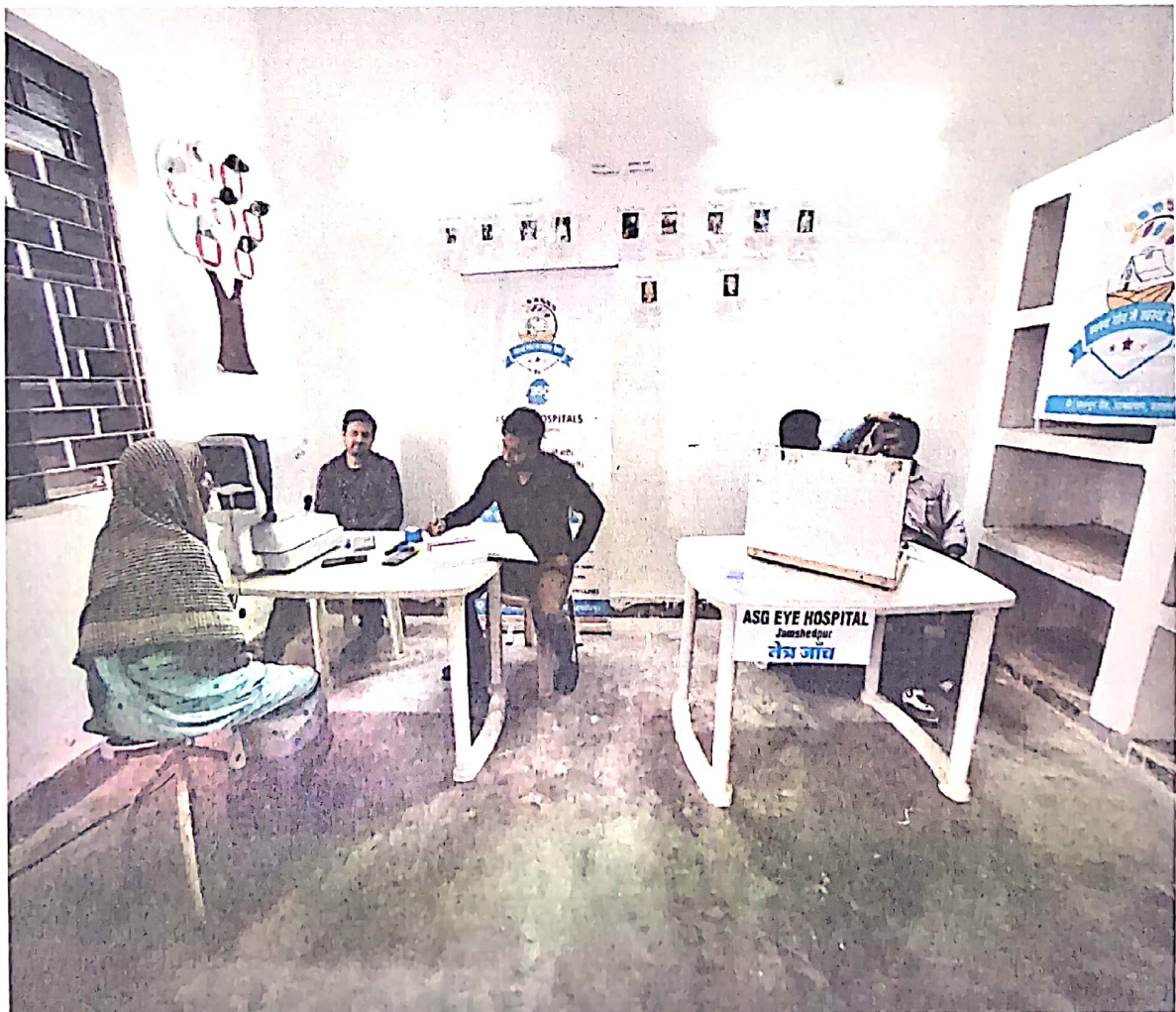

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Organization and Services Provided
