BRIEF HISTORY:

Patamda Degree College, Jalla a Permanent affiliated unit of Kolhan University, Chaibasa, is located at the headquarter of Patamda Block under the district of East Singhbhum at a distance of 30 km. from Jamshedpur. Patamda Block is surrounded by hills and forests and is predominantly populated by the Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe, Extremely Backward and Backward classes. This is primarily an agricultural area and as such per capita income is very low. As per government notification, Patamda Block comes under "Tribal-sub-Plan" area in East Singhbhum district. NATIONAL EDUCATIONAL POLICY(2020)

- This policy envisions a complete overhaul and re-energizing of the higher education system to deliver high-quality higher education, with equity and inclusion.
- 2. The policy's vision includes the following key changes to the current system:

(a) Moving towards a higher educational system consisting of large, multidisciplinary universities and colleges, with at least one in or near every district, and with more HEI across India that offer medium of instruction or programmes in local/Indian languages.

(d) Revamping curriculum, pedagogy, assessment, and student support for enhanced student experiences.

(f) Establishment of a National Research Foundation to fund outstanding peer-reviewed research and to actively encourage seed fund research in universities and colleges.

(g) Governance of HEIs by high qualified independent boards having academic and administrative autonomy.

(h) "lightbuttight" regulation by a single regulator for higher education;

(i) Increased access, equity, and inclusion through a range of measures, including greater opportunities for outstanding public education ,scholarships by private/philanthropic universities for disadvantaged and underprivileged students; online education, and **Open Distance Learning (ODL)**; and all infrastructure and learning materials accessible and available to learners with disabilities

STRUCTURE AND LENGTH OF DEGREE PROGRAMMES:

- The undergraduate degree will be of either 3 or 4-year duration, with multiple exit options within
 this period, with appropriate certifications, e.g., a certificate after completinglyear in a discipline or
 field including vocational and professional areas, or a diploma after 2 years of study, or a
 Bachelor's degree after a 3-year programme.
- An Academic Bank of Credit (ABC) shall be established which would digitally store the academic credits earned from various recognized HEIs so that the degrees from an HEI can be a warded take in to account credits earned.

COURSE STRUCTURE

. DURATION (TIME FRAME) OR VALIDITY OF REGISTRATION

- The UG programme for a regular student shall be for a period of four years with multiple entry and multiple exit options.
- ii. Each academic year shall comprise of two semesters, viz. Odd and Even semesters.
- iii. Odd Semesters shall be from July to December and Even Semesters from January to June.
- Eligibility to take Research courses in Semester VII is to secure a minimum of overall marks 75% (7.5 CGPA) and above up to semester VI along with other criteria of the Institution.
- v. The validity of credits earned/kept in the Academic Bank of Credits account will be 7 years.

The curriculum consists of major stream courses, minor stream courses and courses from other disciplines, language courses, skill courses, and a set of courses on Environmental education, understanding India, Digital and technological solutions, Health & Wellness, Yoga education, and sports and fitness. There will courses from broad disciplinary areas, each having basket of courses:

- i. Natural and Physical Sciences
- ii. Mathematics, Statistics, and Computer Applications
- iii. Library, Information and Media Sciences
- iv. Commerce and Management

- v. Humanities and Social Sciences
- vi. Or others offered by the University

At the time of admission, a student will have to select a 'Major' from any of the broad disciplinary areas. The selection for admission will be primarily based on availability of seats in Major and marks imposed by the institution. A student will also have to select three subjects for NCHARGEAultidisciplinary Courses' from a pool of subjects offered by the institution from the concerned REECOURGE, and disciplinary areas.

COLLEGE LIBRARY
